- The town reports are complete and ready for the public.

- Vermont Transportation Board sent us a ruling on posting roads. The town of Granby does not post our roads as the three towns connecting us already post theirs.
- R Terry and Terri are scheduled to have a final meeting with FEMA on March 4<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 in reference to the FEMA grant.
- The computer monitor has died on us so Mark Fulton lent us his then he picked up a new one for \$109.99.

- The Local Emergency Management Plan is coming up for its yearly update. I checked with Reg to confirm that he will continue to be our Emergency Management Representative. He agreed to.

- R. Terry informed the board that the quote for a generator for the town came in at \$12,253.00. The board agreed to hold off on the purchase for now.
- Terri informed the board that we were not billed for the roofs that were installed over the heat pumps in the town garage.
- John Kascenska attended the meeting and shared the happenings of the legislature. R Terry asked him to investigate a possible insurance policy that would cover road accidents and forest fires. The town presently must pick up the expenses out of pocket according to state law. This is very hard for us to plan and to put a dollar amount into the budget. It cost the town 10% of their budget in 2025.
