CALL TO ORDER

Reg called the meeting to order at 6:29 P.M.

APPROVE MINUTES:

Minutes of the July 28th, 2026 selectboard meeting were reviewed and approved

CITIZEN’S CONCERNS/REQUESTS/INPUT

REPORT FROM THE ROAD COMMISSIONER:

- R. Terry reported that the town has spent a total of \$65,644.63 to date on the Grant for the Granby Road from Austin Road to the Cook Shack. # GA P02256

REPORT FROM THE TOWN CLERK:

- Copies of the “Budget to Actual” for Road and General were presented to the board.
- We have not yet heard back from Passumpsic Bank in reference to our need for a line of credit. Terri L will check into it.
- Terri L presented a copy of the latest draft of the Local Hazard Mitigation Plan. Our grant writer will report back when a final copy has been accepted by the state, and he will set up a final meeting to have us sign off on it.
- The town got an email from the Secretary of States office informing us that there have been roughly 850 registered voters that were put onto the voter rolls by mistake by the DMV. The Secretary of States office has removed those voters and will have a public announcement later in the day.
- Terri L gave the board a heads up that she will be on vacation from October 5th to October 18th.

OLD BUSINESS:

- All present at the meeting agreed that the town wide meeting was a success.
- There was further discussion about the increase in costs of garbage pickup. The increase totals about \$6,500 in a calendar year. There was further discussion as to other options for garbage pickup. It was agreed by the board to investigate a price quote from D4 Dan out of Groveton.

- The board also voted to except the request of Vaughn Hodgdon Rubbish Removal to go back to every other Saturday from 9 to 10 starting September 5h.
- The selectboard voted to spend the remainder of the MERP grant on fixing up the bottom of the town garage and putting up siding that doesn't now exist on the back of the office portion of the building. Reg will investigate getting an estimate.
- Terri's request for a dumpster for the town is waiting on a quote for the repairs to the town garage and the possible need for a dumpster for that project. Maybe the town can use the same dumpster.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Terri L brought to the attention of the board that Digsafe is available for anytime the town may have a need to dig up the ground on town property.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- R. Terry reminded the rest of the board that we still have \$24,980.55 to decide what to do with.
- Terri L asked Reg if he could recall why the town has a Municipal Conservation Saving Account at the Passumpsic bank in the amount of \$305.64. He did not recall. We will transfer that money to the Road Account and close out the saving account.
- Terri L informed the board that our copier contract has run out. She is not sure exactly how that affects us but will investigate.
