CALL TO ORDER

Reg called the meeting to order at 6:24 P.M.

APPROVE MINUTES:

Minutes of April 28, 2026, selectboard meeting was reviewed and approved

CITIZEN’S CONCERNS/REQUESTS/INPUT

REPORT FROM THE ROAD COMMISSIONER:

- R Terry reminded the board that there are three grants in the works for roads – Town Highway Class 2 Roadway Program Grant, Vtrans Grants in Aids Awards – State Fiscal Year 2027 and FY2027 Better Roads Category B Grant
- He is still trying to catch up with Bruce Berryman to discuss Bruce’s driveway. He and Casey looked at the driveway and have suggestions.
- R Terry did some research on potential grant money to buy signs for private driveways. The state has nothing to offer at this time. It was suggested by the state to put this expense into a future budget.
- The mess at the town garage lawn has been fixed.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN CLERK:

Terri L. reported the following:

- The Hodgdon Trucking 2026 contract has been signed by all parties. The new contract is in effect on July 8th. The new pickup hours will be Wednesdays from 7 to 8. The board was concerned about it being in the middle of the week so Reg is going to reach out to them to see if they can pick up on Saturdays during the winter months.

- The general account presently has a balance of roughly \$29,000 but Terri L feels confident that we will be all set to pay bills as needed until the property tax money starts coming in.
- NEKWMD has a price increase and noted as such.
- Overweight permits were signed for Structural Wood Corporation DBA Roll Lock Truss. Another was signed for Larry Brown Logging and Chipping Inc. and McElwain Contracting, LLC.
- There are trees on the GMP lines on Granby Road. Tyler will call and have them come out and take care of the issue.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Issues with where exactly Paul Stream Road is located signaled the selectboard to rename the section that is located in the town of Granby. That section is now named "Granby Stream Road". This was communicated to and agreed upon with our state 911 coordinator and other state agencies. Maps now show the change. See attached.
- The selectboard requested to have Terri L notify the members of town that at the next selectboard meeting, the decision will be made on how to spend the \$25,000 remaining from a grant from last year.
- Tyler checked on the jammed schoolhouse basement door. He reports that it's all set now.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Terri L asked the board what should happen to the old copier that is presently stored in the town garage office section. Reg suggested that it go to Lyndonville to the entity that takes old electronics to be fixed and sold.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Terri L. presented an updated "Budget to Actual" report for town and road.
- The board asked Terri L to reach out to GMP to have them explain why our electricity bill is so inconsistent from month to month.

ADJOURN:

Reg Bunnell adjourned the meeting at 7:30 pm.
